Our Volunteer Coordinator is also happy to speak with you and help you discern where you might serve.

Do not live entirely isolated, having retreated into yourselves, as if you were already justified, but gather instead to seek the common good together.

Priority Volunteer Needs

Holy Spirit Guild ... Needs 3 volunteers & 1 leader

WHAT DOES THE GUILD DO?

This Guild assists with infant/toddler baptisms. Volunteers (called baptismal hosts) ready the baptism area of church with supplies needed during baptisms. They greet and offer support to the families while at church for the baptism. This sacrament is celebrated on Sundays after the 11 AM Mass. Volunteers spend about 1 hour every 4 to 6 weeks.

Guild members also organize and hostess an annual potluck supper in January for the families who had a baby baptized during the year.

WHAT DOES THE LEADER DO?

The Leader of the Holy Spirit Guild builds camaraderie among their volunteers and handles Guild business during a monthly meeting directed by the leader. The Leader may also choose to take a turn acting as a host for a baptism.

The Holy Spirit Guild Leader is considered part of the Women's Club Board and attends 1 monthly Women's Club Board Meeting where planning happens and friendships grow. The time commitment for the leader is 2 to 3 hours a month.

Women's Club Board ... Needs a Treasurer

The Treasurer is responsible for keeping the treasures book that documents account details for all financial matters concerning the Women's Club. She will keep account of all monies, receive all money that comes to the club, distribute club funds, make deposits, pay bills, invest savings according to by-laws and give a written accounting at Board meetings.

The position requires basic knowledge of math, balancing a checkbook and a comfort level with numbers.

The Treasurer attends a monthly Women's Club Board meeting. Beyond the meeting, the time commitment is an additional half-hour or less each month. During the fundraising month and at the end of the fiscal year, an additional hour or two is needed.

St. Gabriel Guild Ministry ... Needs 2 or 3 Leaders & several volunteers

WHAT DOES THE GUILD DO?

This Guild hosts Donut Sundays 6 times a year, an annual RCIA brunch and on occasion a few special parish events. Volunteers do one or more of the following: serve beverages and food, room set-up, make beverages, clean up. Donut Sundays are held the first Sunday of October, November, December, February, March and May after 9 AM and 11 AM Masses. Currently, the Women's Club splits the free-will offering with which ever group volunteers to serve that day. The Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and 8th grade class have served to raise funds and as a service to the Parish. The RCIA Brunch is held within a week or two after Easter. It is to welcome new converts into the Parish. The St. Catherine Guild members prepare the food and the St. Gabriel Guild serves the food. A volunteer in this guild will spend about 2 hours a month from October – May.



WHAT DOES THE LEADER DO?

The leaders of the St. Gabriel's Guild build camaraderie among their volunteers and handles guild business, such as shopping for food and supplies. Most other business is conducted by phone or e-mail. The Guild currently has 3 co-leaders who share the tasks. The St. Gabriel Guild Leaders are considered part of the Women's Club Board and attend 1 monthly board meeting where planning happens and friendships grow. The time commitment for the leader is 2 to 3 hours a month September-May.

Prayer Shawl Ministry ... Invites new members

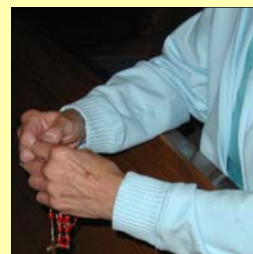

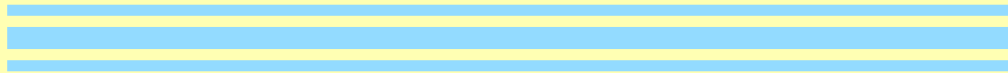
