

Dear St. Peter Family,

I hope this letter finds you and your loved ones well. Here at St. Peter Parish, our community continues to live out our shared faith through prayer, support of our parish ministries, and participation in the life of our parish, whether through attending Mass, participating as a volunteer, or serving as one of our parish leaders. Sometimes it may seem we are in our own world here at St. Peter, however we are part of a larger faith community of more than 400,000 Catholics spanning 11 counties and 105 parishes in northern Illinois.
