Here at St. Peter Parish, our community continues to live out our shared faith through prayer, support of our parish ministries, and participation in the life of our parish, whether through attending Mass, participating as a volunteer, or serving as one of our parish leaders. 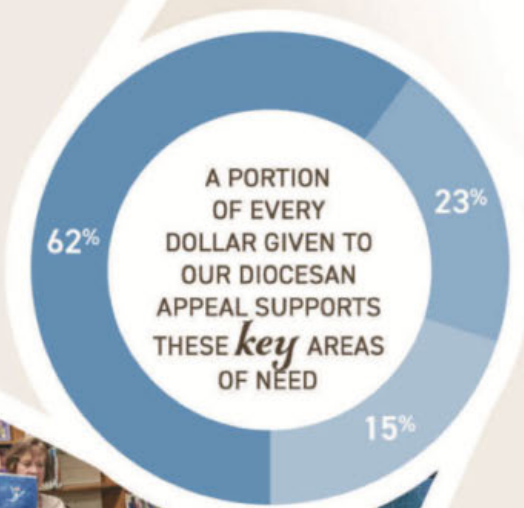

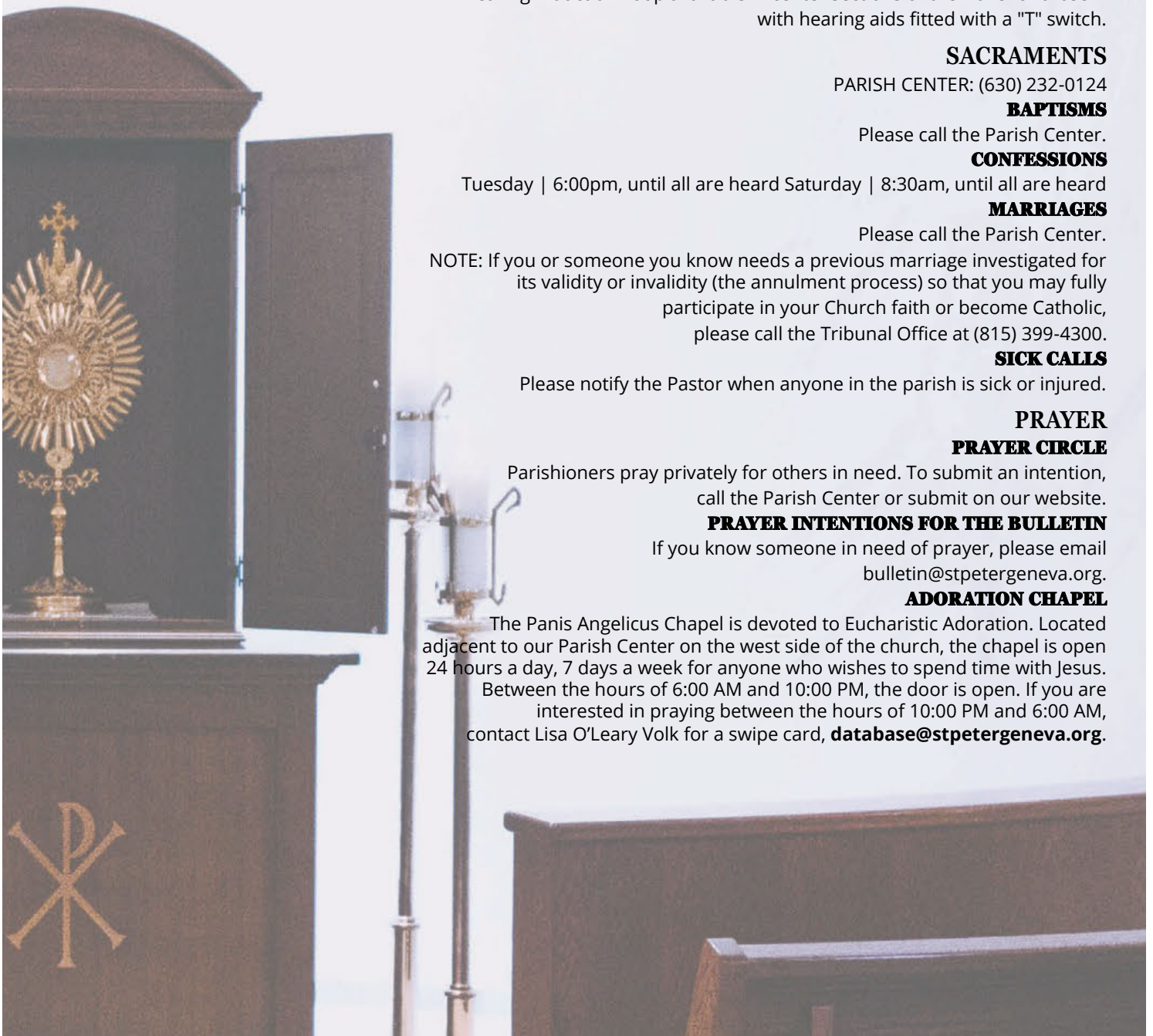

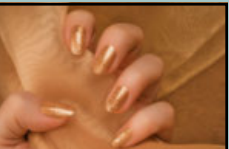
