

Pro-Tips for Greater Eucharistic Devotion



- Go to Mass every single Sunday. Somebody once said, show me your calendar and I'll show you what you love. If we love Jesus, we show up.
- Remain silent in church. Foster an attitude of prayer and wonder. Notice the tabernacle and recognize there's something greater than me here. It also allows others to pray in reverent silence as well.
- When passing the tabernacle or entering your pew, make a slow, intentional genuflection with your right knee going all the way to the floor and touching it (you can bow if unable to genuflect).
- Spend some time with Jesus in the Adoration chapel. He's in ours 24/7 and you can go in there and pray with Him any time. People love it.
- 5. Whenever you pass a Catholic Church make the sign of the Cross slowly and pray this prayer: O Jesus, truly present in the Most Blessed Sacrament, may you be praised, blessed, and adored, in all the tabernacles throughout the world now until the end of time. Amen.
- 6. Pay super attention at the consecration. You're literally witnessing a miracle.
- Pray before and after receiving Holy Communion. Do your best to meditate
 on the gift you've just been given. Ask for a grace. Pray the Mass for an
 intention.
- 8. Learn about Eucharistic miracles. There's lots of them!
- 9. Be aware of just Who the Eucharist is and be conscious of that sublime reality in speech, dress, conduct, etc.
- 10. Receive Holy Communion reverently:
 - a. Be intentional
 - b. Be smooth and measured
 - c. Upon approaching the minister make a profound bow
 - d. Whether receiving in the tongue or on the hand be clear and intentional with your gestures.
 - e. If receiving in the hand, take one step away from the minister. Place Jesus in the Eucharist in your mouth. Make the sign of the Cross and return to your pew.
 - f. Under no circumstances can we walk away with the Host. This is for two reasons, first, reverence for the Blessed Sacrament and second, the safety of the Blessed Sacrament. Jesus must always be consumed immediately.






RETURNING TO THE SOURCE
