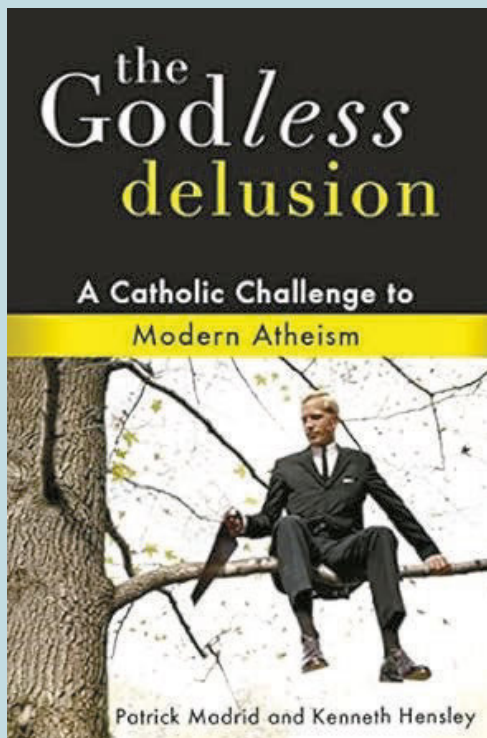

ANNUAL CROSS MEMORIAL DISPLAY

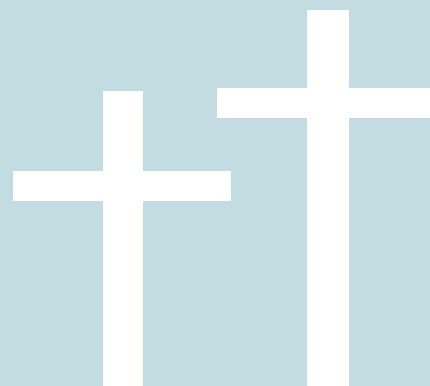


