





from several parishes in our district gathered at the Fabyan Forest Preserve on a beautiful September Day. About 40 of those were from St. Peter! For our first annual walk we were able to raise \$3,185.45 to help friends in need! Thanks to all who supported the walk in any way.

On another wonderful note, at our last meeting, after prayer, formation and discernment, we were privileged to commission FIVE new active members and one new associate member. Special appreciation was extended to Joe Oetter, outgoing Treasurer. Special gratitude was extended in memorium to Matt Bales as a founding member and mentor in our founding years. A huge vote of gratitude was extended to Kevin O'Dea as president emeritus for his leadership, wisdom, support, humility and love for seven years.

New officers were inducted: Theresa Heaton, President, Jim Golick, Vice- President, Maureen Grady, Treasurer, and Nancy Dantino, Secretary. Vicky Julitz, spiritual Advisor, remains, as mentioned previously. All Vincentians lovingly pledged constant support to our Society and our leaders, our friends-in-need, our pastor and our Parrish Family.

Lastly, by way of the traditional Annual Report to the Pastor and the Parish, for SVDP Fiscal Year 2023, 12 active members spent 581 hours of service helping 71 friends in need during 32 home visits and other in-kind visits. A total of \$34,243 were distributed to neighbors, with \$24,919 in the category of housing assistance and eviction prevention. Other categories included automobile assistance, medical, dental and more. The official annual report was submitted to the District and National Conferences per By-Laws.
