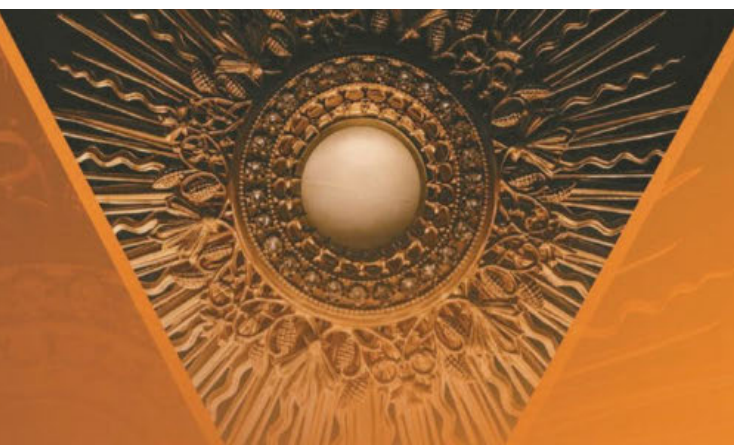

Most of us start each day with a cup of coffee to lift our spirits and get our day started on the right foot. But not everyone can afford that boost we take for granted each morning. Our Food Pantry distributes to approximately 300 needy families each month. The food pantry has a lofty goal this year, to provide each family with one pound of ground coffee with each Christmas meal. This is an extra that we can only provide through your generosity, as coffee isn't a product that the food pantry is able to purchase through The Northern Illinois Food Bank.

Can you please help us provide this PERK?

You can either...

1. Buy a pound of Ground Coffee and drop it off in the Food Collection boxes located in church or outside the Food Pantry door, located on the West side of the parish office.

WOMEN'S CATHOLIC BOOK CLUB

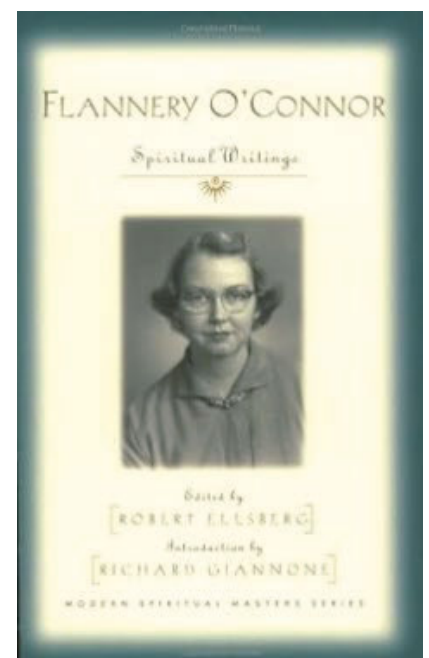
Tuesday, December 12th—9AM

RORATE COELI MASS

Thursday, December 14th—6:45 AM

Come join us for our seventh annual Rorate Coeli Mass. This Mass is celebrated during Advent wherein the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary is offered just before dawn. The interplay of light and darkness speaks to the meaning of Advent and the coming of the Light of the world.

The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight.

Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's Honor, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet. As the Mass proceeds and sunrise approaches, the church becomes progressively brighter, illumined by the sun as our faith is illumined by Christ.
