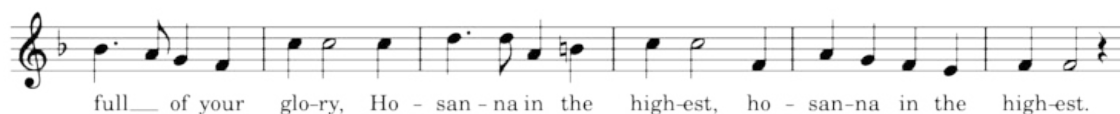

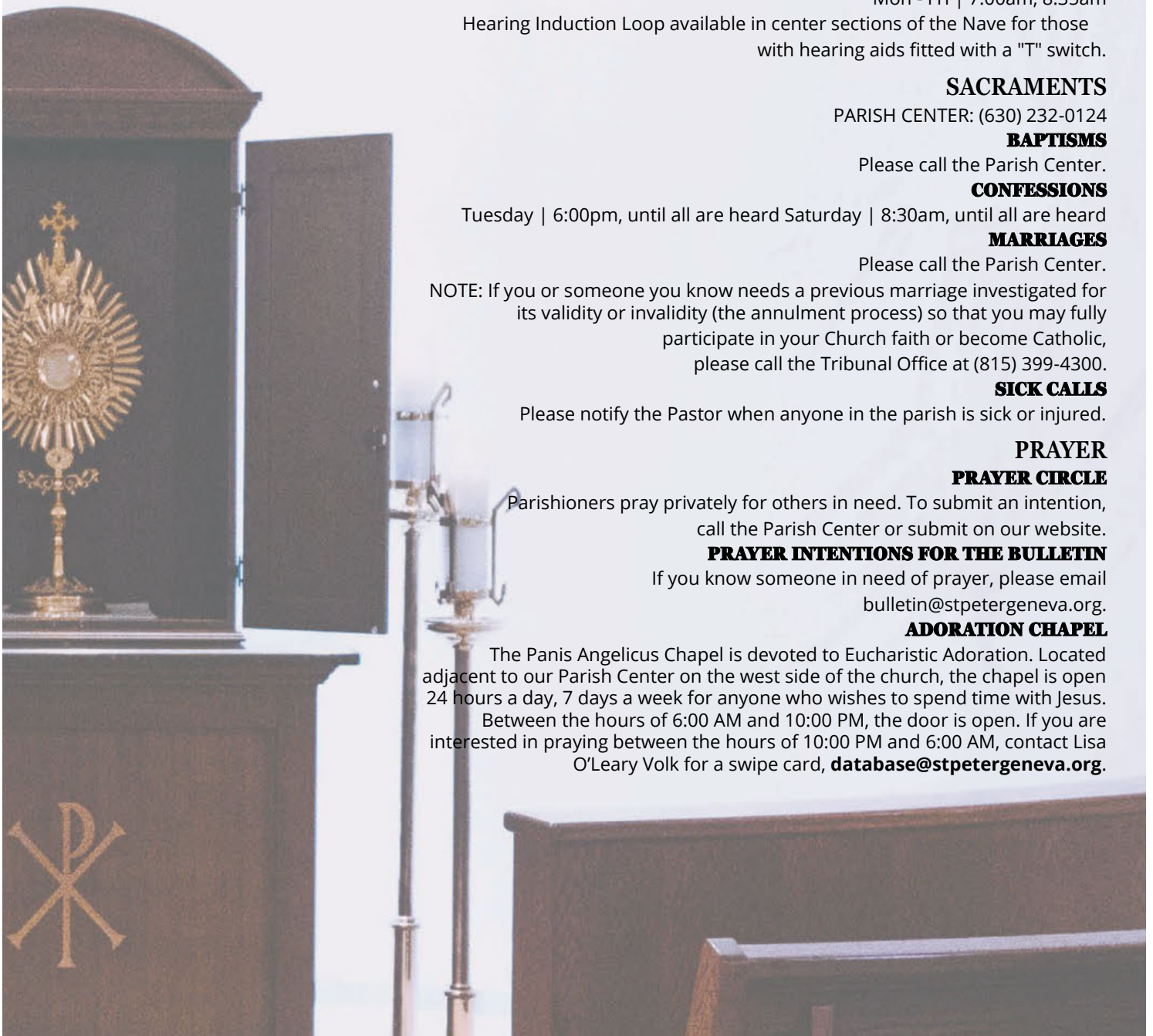

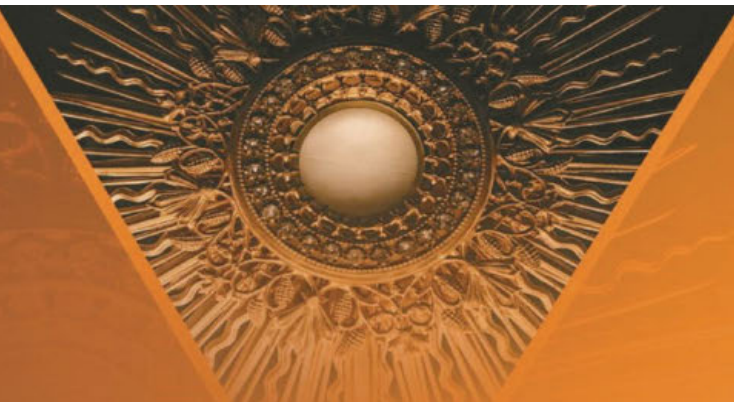

FATHER JOHN MUI

How marvelous, then, that Jesus begins his ministry by proclaiming: “Repent!” We tend to think it means “stop doing bad things” but it doesn’t. It literally means “go beyond the mind you have.” Think in a new way. It’s painful to admit, but some portion of my mind is addicted to lie-telling, usually to protect my ego or make life easier. To repent means to admit this tendency, to say, “I’m done lying,” and to move beyond my split mind into a complete commitment to the truth. Perhaps that’s why at Mass we together proclaim, “I have sinned in my thoughts, and in my words...” Repentance and truth-telling work together.

Fox Valley Catholic Bible Study for Women

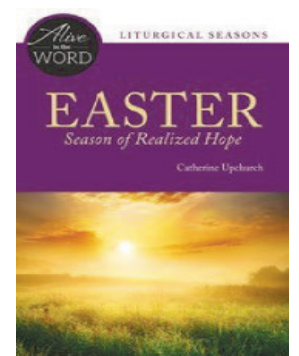
Thursdays at 9am

Starting February 1, 2024, all women are invited to begin a study of *The Holy Spirit in the Bible* at St John Neumann. Then, after a short break, we will continue with a 3-week study about our greatest feast, Easter, from April 11 to 25.

Using Little Rock Scripture Study materials by Liturgical Press, we will explore the role of the Holy Spirit at Creation, in Israel, in the ministry of Jesus and the early church. We will also see how the Holy Spirit acts in our own personal and spiritual lives. Our Easter study allows us to linger a bit with the experience of Jesus' Resurrection, joining the women at the tomb, and the other disciples, and learning the importance of the Resurrection from Paul.

Gatherings are held in the Hermes Center at 9 AM. A large group reflection begins at 9:15 AM, followed by small group discussion of the lesson. A Zoom option is available. The \$30 registration fee includes all study materials. Structured childcare is offered for children aged 2 and older for a one-time fee of \$10. Children under 2 stay with their moms in a special group.

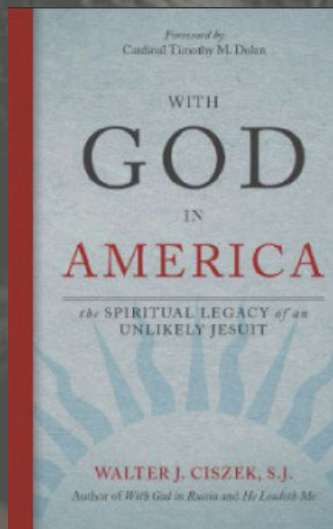

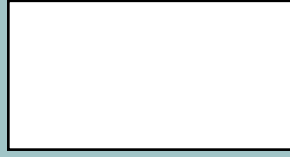
