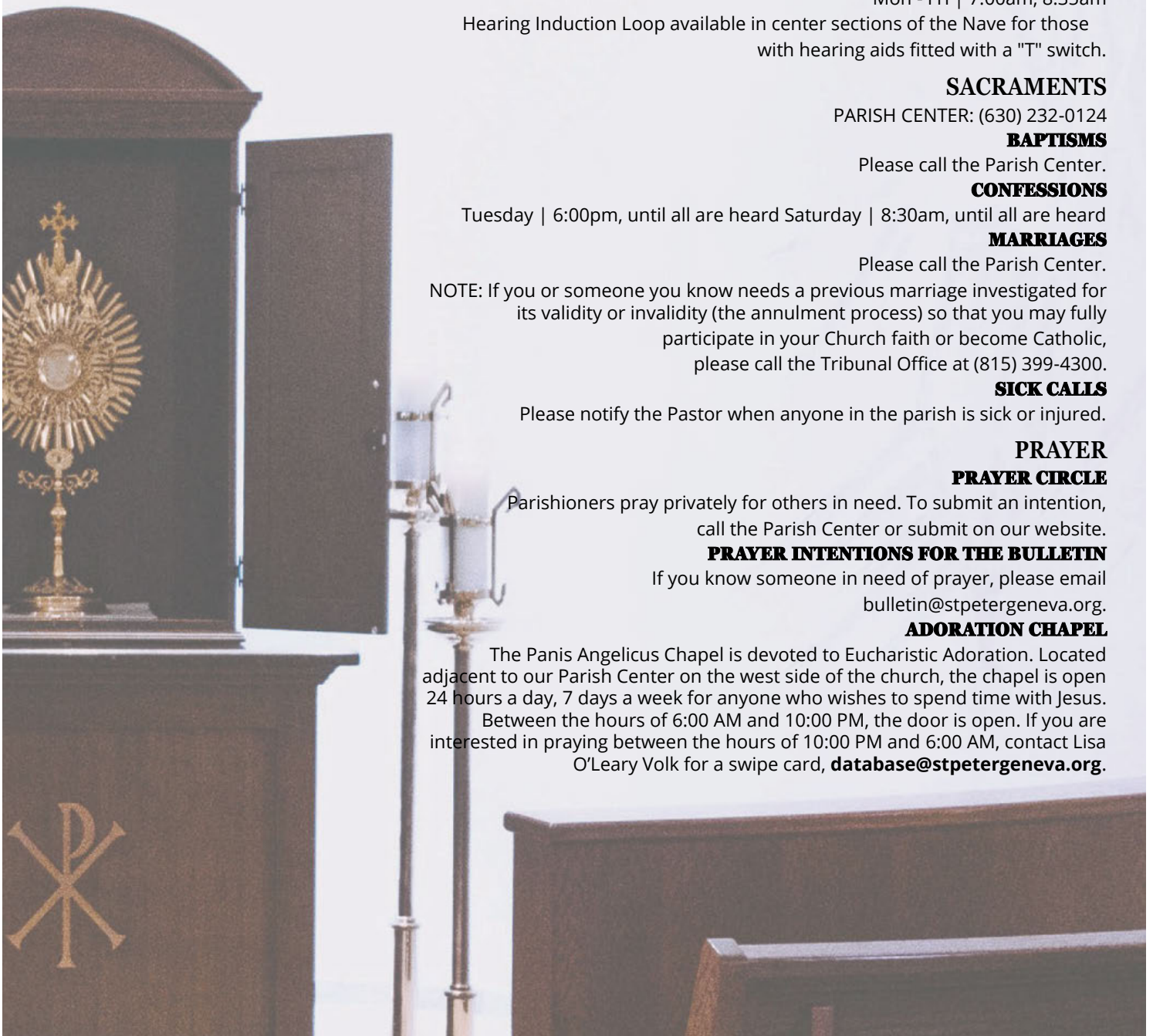

Fox Valley Catholic Bible Study for Women

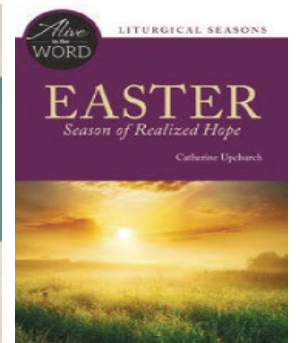
Thursdays at 9am

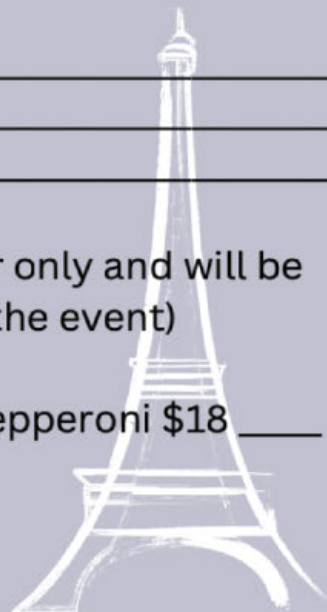

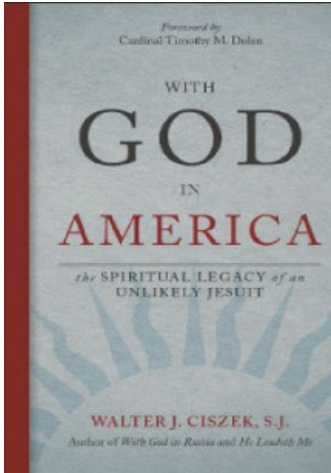

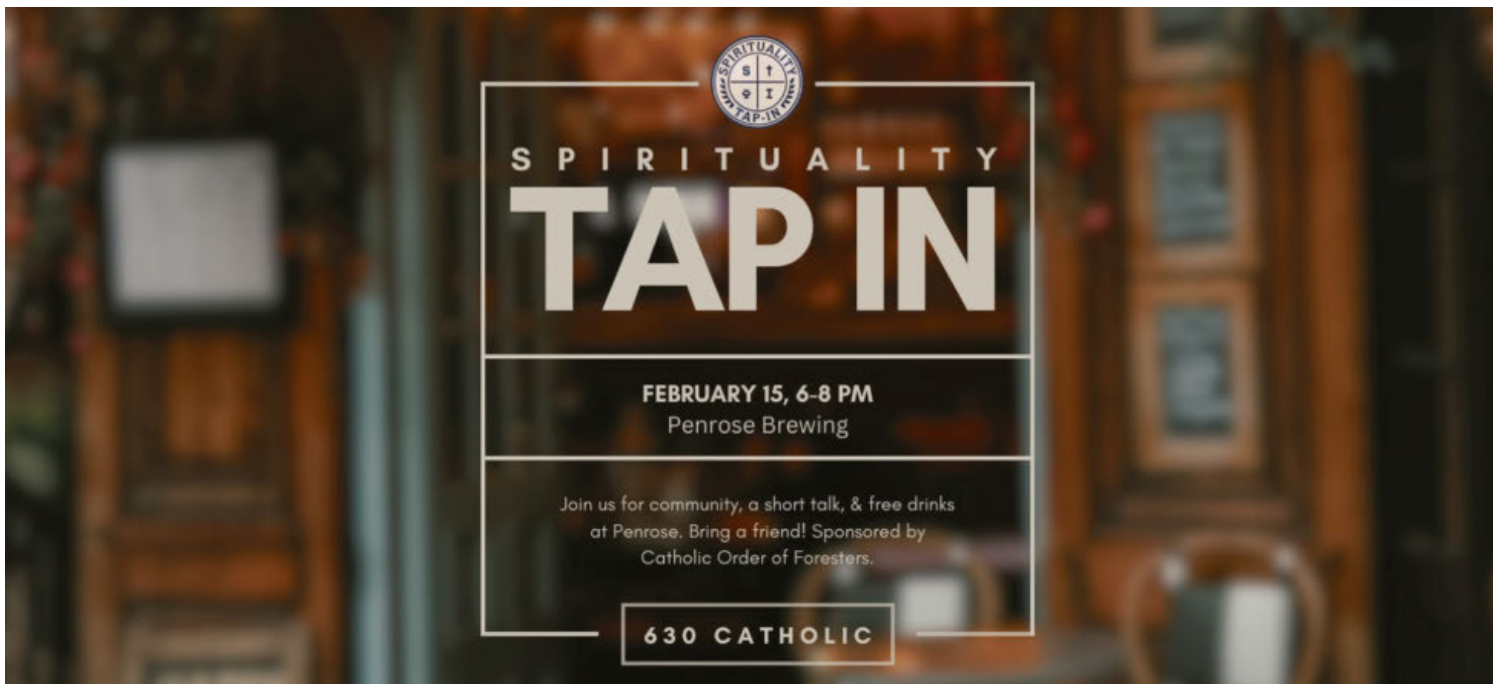


WOMEN'S CATHOLIC BOOK CLUB Tuesday, February 20th—9AM

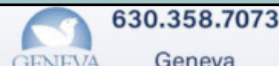

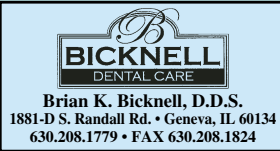


