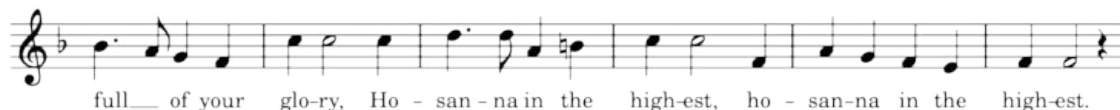

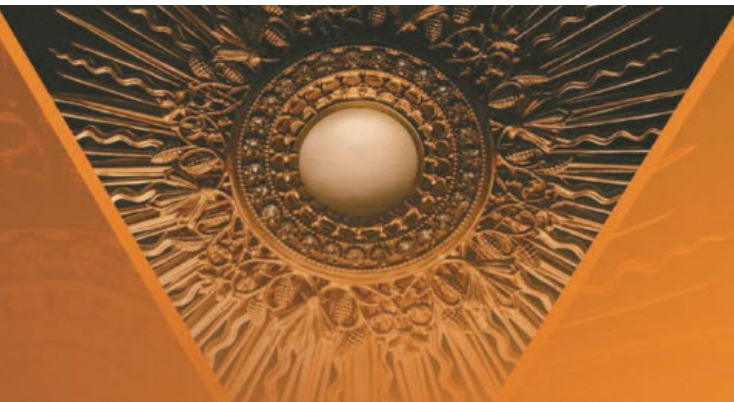

Thursdays at 9am

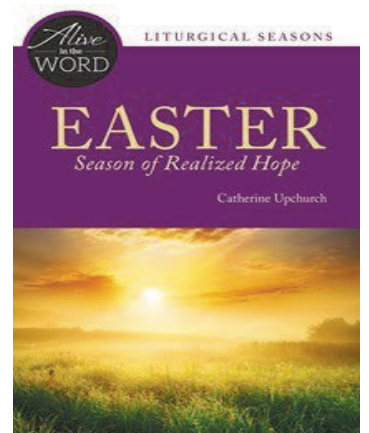

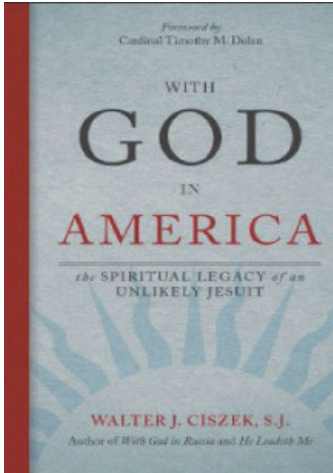
