

"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few".

How many times have we heard these words? What do they mean to us when we hear them? To the members of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul here at St. Peter Church it is a call to serve those in our community. While we might not be aware of how some find it difficult to always meet the needs of their families, we know that there are many who struggle to meet even the most basic necessities to live a life in comfort and peace. The members of our Society have seen how we can change that.

Members of The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) Geneva Conference have seen these needs first hand. Over the past six years, many families have called upon the Society to help them when their lives have been disrupted by financial burdens. These could have been caused by many factors but the cause is less important than the impact it's had on their lives. As Catholics we are called by Jesus to reach out with a helping hand. Sometimes it doesn't need to be financial assistance but more than those in need to know there are others out there who are ready to help when called upon.

To do this we must have enough laborers, just as Jesus knew that this was needed when He said this to his disciples. We need additional volunteers to keep our Conference thriving for those in need.

SVDP is calling on our parishioners to be part of this important ministry. If you've ever thought to yourself "What can I do to answer Jesus' call to help those in need?", then being a part of SVDP might be just what you are looking for. Our members can share with you how much they have been changed by the experience of reaching out when others have found life to be a struggle on occasion.

Most importantly, we as Vincentians do things a little differently. When we are called upon to help those who contact us, we don't ask them to come to us but we go to them. Through Home Visits, we are welcomed into their homes and we strive to create an environment where they truly know we want to help them in any way we can. We do not only answer the call to help members of our parish, but also anyone who seeks help within our community. It is through our desire to live out our faith by hearing the calls of those in need that we grow in our own understanding of what Jesus calls us to do.

As a Society, we are reaching out to all of you who may be hearing Jesus calling you to be a part of our ministry. We would be happy to provide more information of what we do upon request. 




