TODAY IS DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

A Day of Extraordinary Graces

St. Faustina was a Polish nun in the early part of the 20th century. Jesus told her that on the Sunday following Easter, special graces and abundant mercy would be available to those souls who seek them.

"On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment."

This is an extraordinary gift from our Lord, who wants us to know His great love and mercy for us. When we make a good confession, our sins are forgiven, but not the atonement due for those sins. On Divine Mercy Sunday, Our Lord also forgives the punishment due to our sins (purgatory). Come and spend an hour with Jesus in grateful thanksgiving and repentance for our sins. Several priests will be available to hear confessions beginning at 2:00 p.m., but it is not necessary to go to confession on that day. The Church allows you to go to confession within the 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday, *provided you remain in a state of grace*. If you went to confession on March 20th, Be Reconciled Day, and are still in a state of grace, you have met the requirement.


Join members of our parish as we pray across from Planned Parenthood in Aurora for an end to abortion of all the innocent infants murdered under the guise of aid/services for women.


The Rosary: A Special Way to Pray






