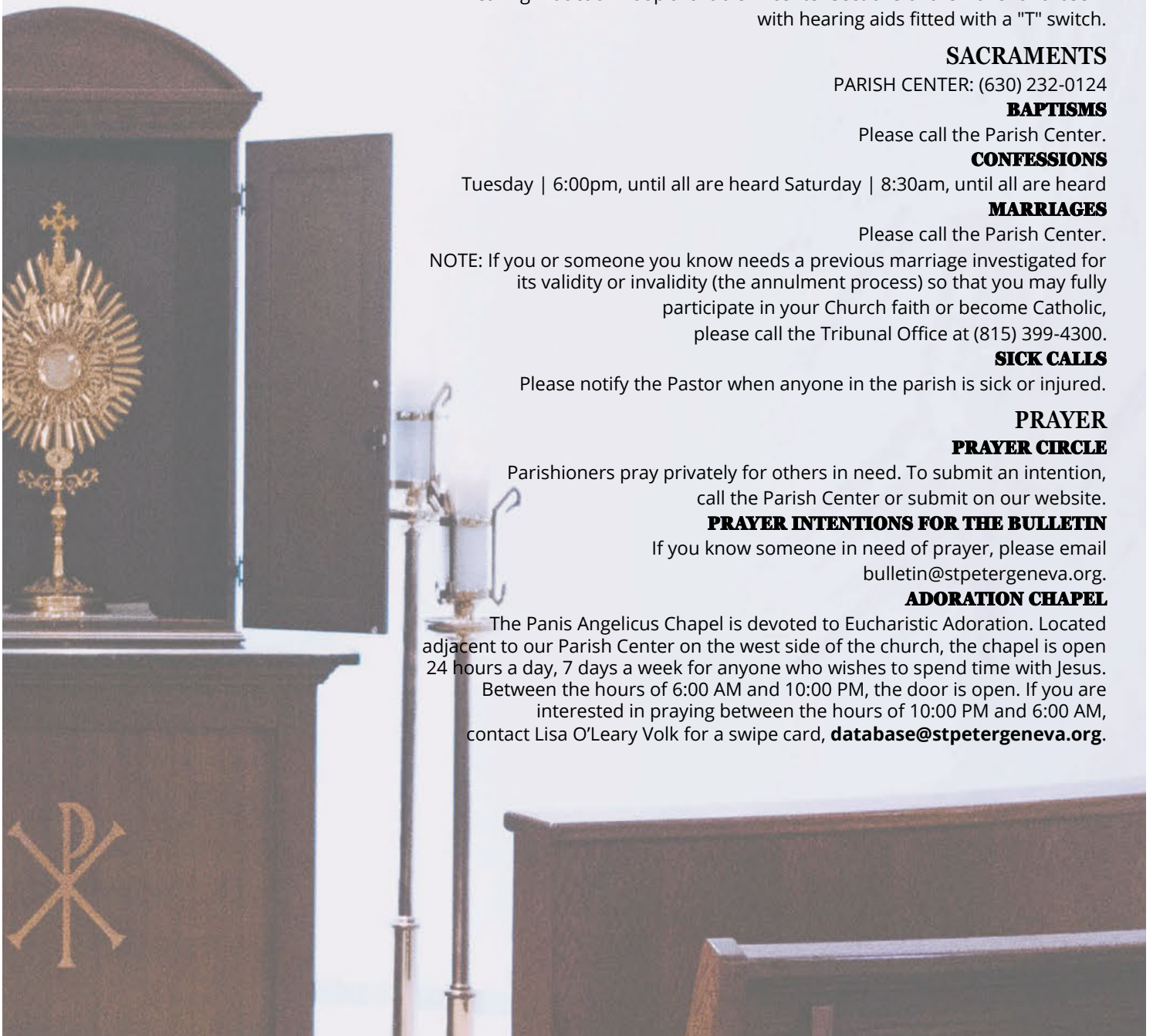

ADORATION CHAPEL

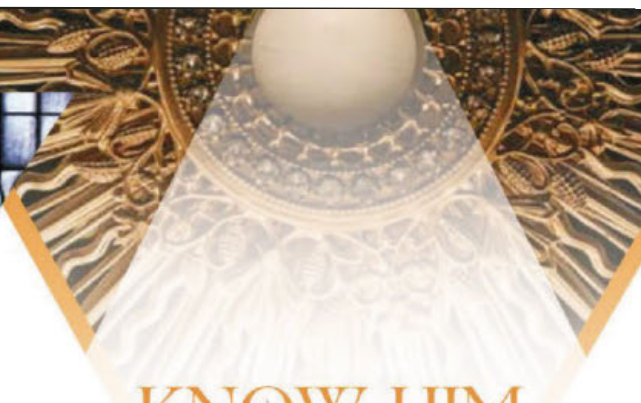
