




REMINDER: NEXT SUNDAY, APRIL 16TH, IS DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Mark your calendars and join us for Confession at 2:00 PM and Holy Hour and Chaplet at 3:00 PM.

One of Jesus' greatest gifts to us is His unlimited mercy. On Divine Mercy Sunday Jesus pours out His mercy and grants us special graces.

St. Faustina was a Polish nun (1905-1938) whom our Lord asked to proclaim His message of mercy to the whole world. He told St. Faustina:

"I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (St. Faustina's Diary #699)

A plenary indulgence is also available to those who have the intention of gaining the indulgence and who meet the necessary requirements: making a good confession shortly before or after Divine Mercy Sunday, receiving Holy Communion (in a state of grace) that day, and reciting the Our Father, the Creed, a prayer for the intentions of the Pope, and a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus, e.g. "Merciful Jesus, I trust in You." The prayers should be said in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, exposed or reserved in the tabernacle.




SUPPORT FOR THOSE WHO HAVE LOST A LOVED ONE TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE




Holy Cross parishes. The group is in its 25th year!


