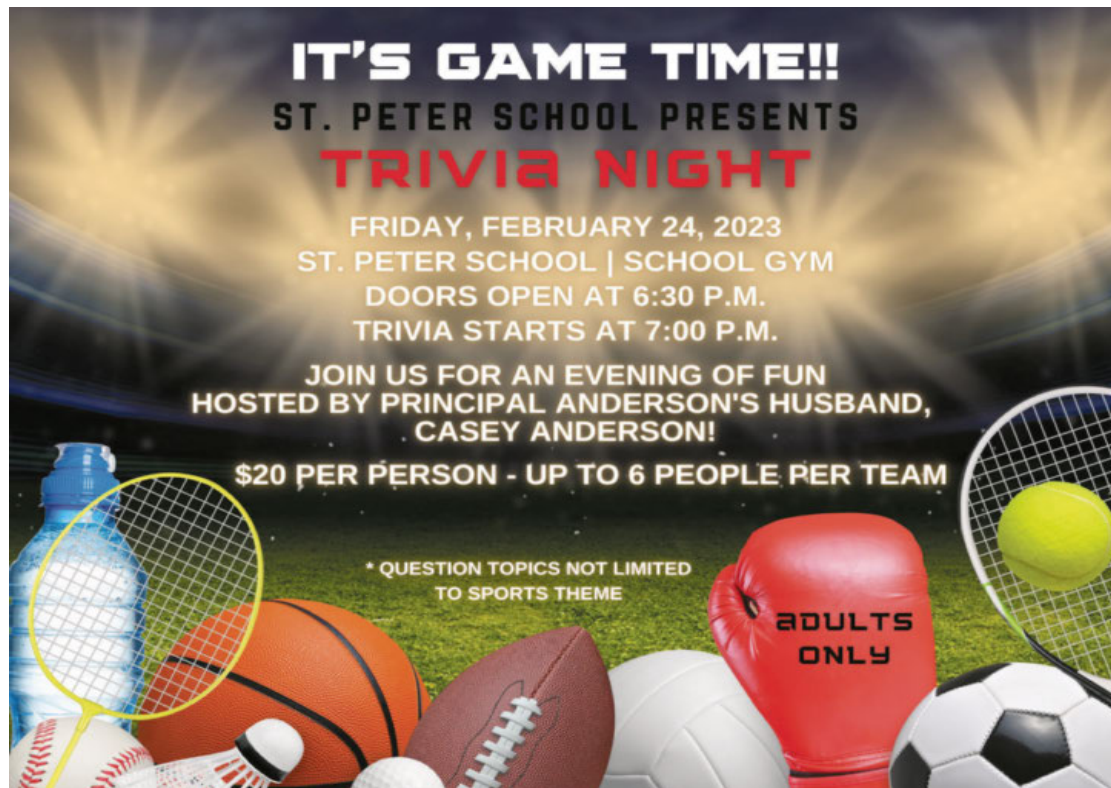
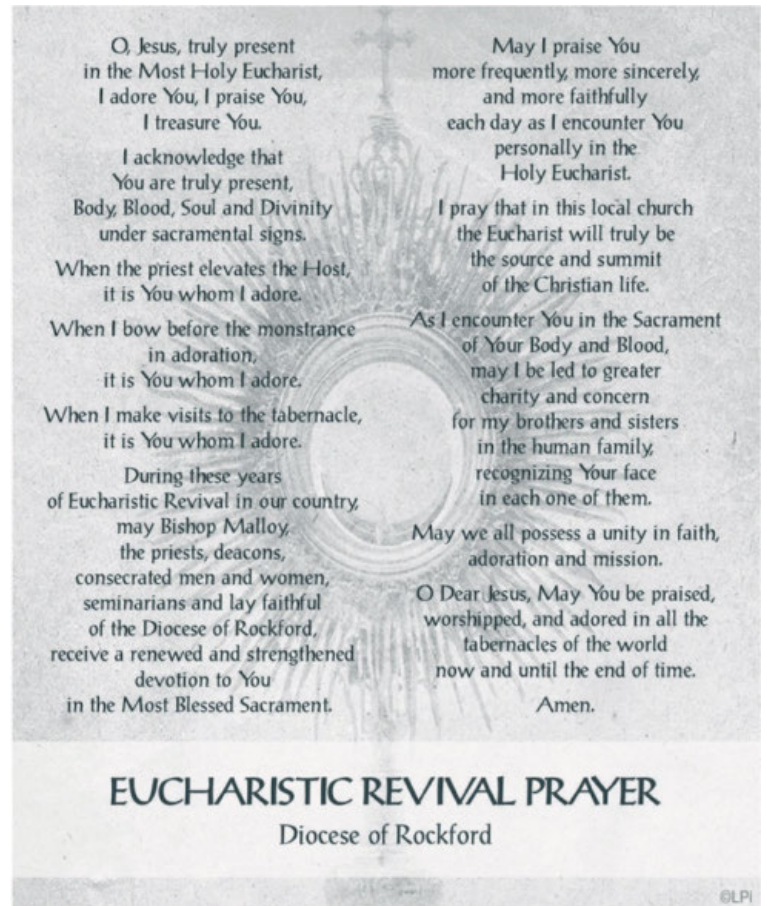

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR MARCH

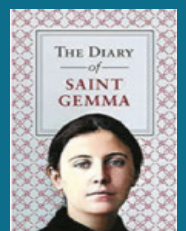

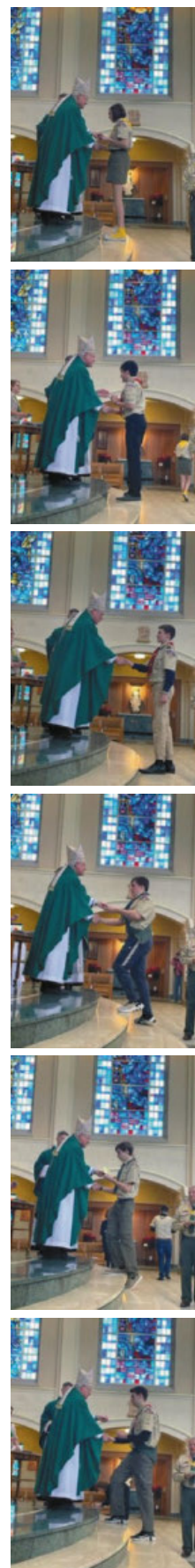

Sanctuary Course for Catholics

Would you value joining others in a conversation about mental health? Would you like to discover what God, Scripture, and Church have to say in light of the experiences of mental health challenges? The subject matter feels particularly relevant in these times of heightened anxiety, and the course creates an opportunity to connect with and support each other in meaningful ways.

ABOUT THE COURSE
The Sanctuary Course for Catholics is an eight-part course for small groups designed to raise awareness and start conversations in local parishes regarding mental health. It was created in collaboration with Catholic mental health professionals, theologians, and clergy, and offers faith communities the opportunity to learn about mental health and grow in their ability to support members living with mental health challenges. Topics covered include: mental health and mental illness, stigma, recovery, companionship, self-care, and community. The sessions are accompanied by compelling films that feature the stories of Catholics living with mental health challenges, along with the insights of archbishops, theologians, and psychologists.

Catholic Charities invites you to join in viewing and discussing the *Sanctuary Course for Catholics*. We will view the films together followed by group discussion. All are welcome!



The course will begin Wednesday, March 1, 2023 at 7PM—8:30PM and run for 8 consecutive weeks, skipping Holy week, using Microsoft Teams online.

HOPE & HEALING AFTER ABORTION

Do you know someone who is carrying the grief, sorrow or regret of abortion? Have you lost a child to abortion? Is your soul aching? Do you feel broken, sad or alone? Too often we think hope and healing are out of our reach. But the mercy of Jesus and the compassion of others are waiting for all. 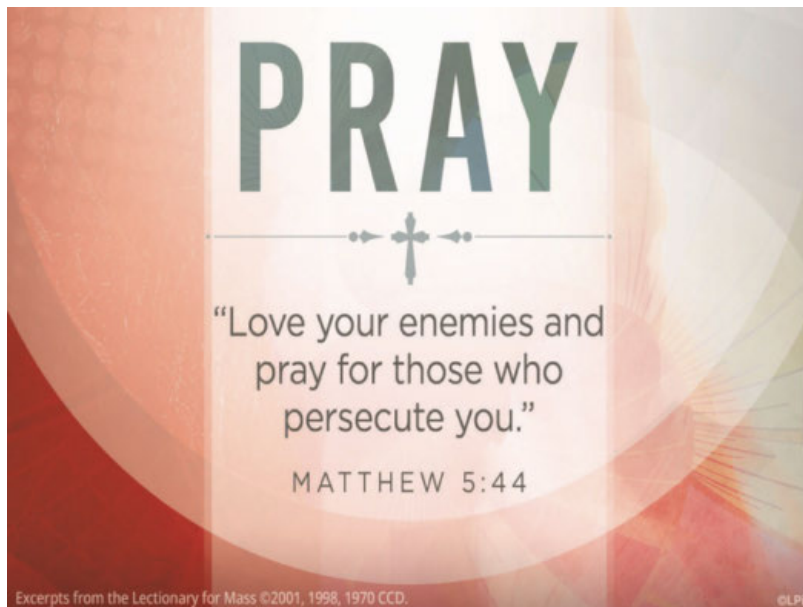
