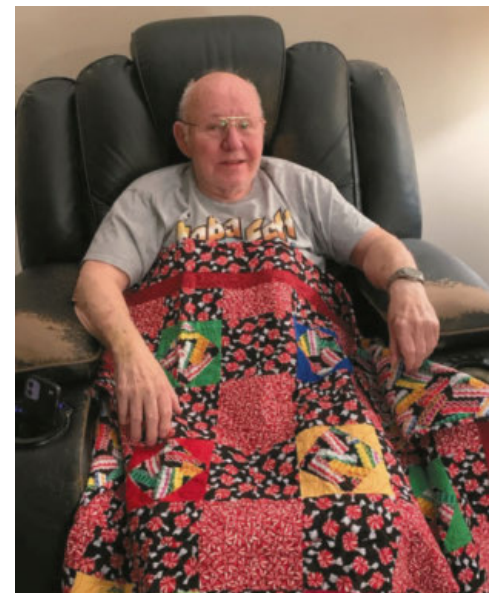
ANNUAL BLESSING OF THE QUILTS FOR THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND

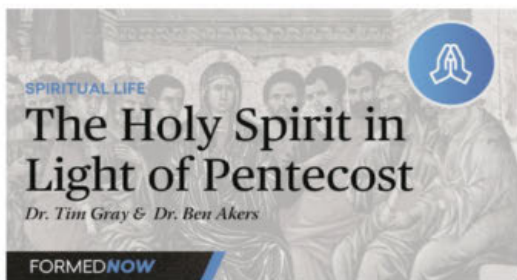

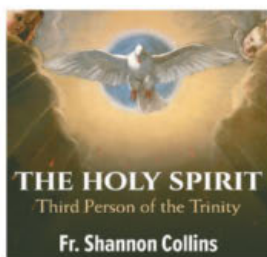
Pentecost | Sacred Art

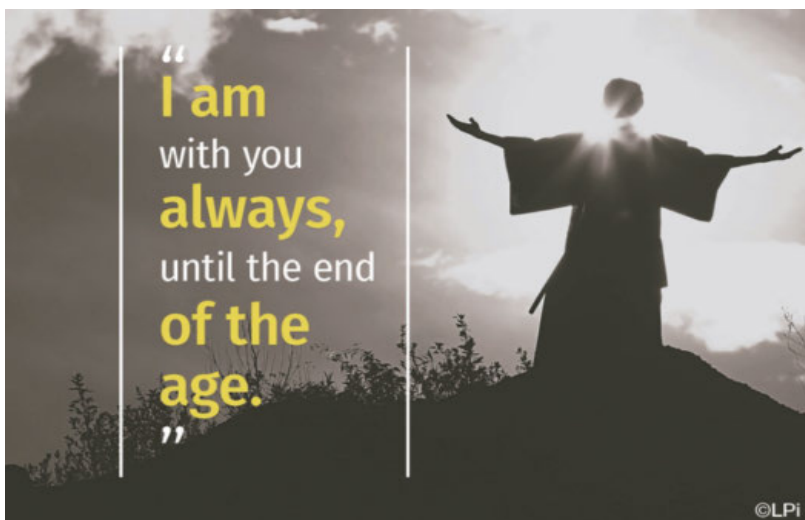
