Our mission is simple, from Matthew 25:40, "Whatsoever you do to the least of my people, that you do unto me."







—WEEK TWO—

May 8 | Unwind & refresh: Read a good book (try Psalm 139) today.

May 9 | Reframe a thought: Identify one negative thought you've been struggling with and write down two other ways to view the situation. (Remember you are wonderfully made!)

May 10 | Learn something new: Listen to a Catholic educational podcast or watch a documentary. (Try Fr. Mike Schmitz Catholic Podcast)

May 11 | Get cooking: Make at least one home-cooked meal today, and be sure to include greens.

May 12 | Breathe: Try box-breathing. Breathe out slowly, releasing all the air from your lungs. Breathe in through your nose as you slowly count to four in your head. Hold your breath for a count of four. Exhale for another count of four. Hold your breath again for a count of four. Repeat for three to four rounds.

May 13 | Dedicate 30 minutes to movement: Stretch, exercise or dance, whatever you choose!

May 14 | Write a thank you prayer for your mother today. If possible, give it to her.




